The Institute

DR. SHASHI BHUSHAN INSTITUTE OF EDUCATION has been started in 1996 with due permission from the Assam University Silchar and subsequently recognized by N.C.T.E, (ERC) Bhubaneswar

Location

It is located at Lakshirbond, Hailakandi, Assam, on its own land.

Category of students entitled for admission:

Both in service and pre-service candidates are eligible for admission on the basis of merit to equip them with the theoretical knowledge and practical skills that are considered necessary to attain professional competence for the secondary level teachers.

Eligibility for admission

Degree / P.G. Degree in Arts, Science and Commerce from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks. In service candidates must produce 'No Objection Certificate' from their employer at the time of admission or to be deputed by the education department. Students coming from universities other than the Assam University must procure the 'Migration Certificate' and get themselves registered with the Assam University, Silchar.

Selection procedure:

1. Candidates both in service and pre service are to collect prescribed application form, prospectus etc. from the college office or from www.sbieducation.com and submit the application form duly filled in along with the necessary testimonials (Mark sheets, Certificates etc.) within the prescribed time. The candidates who have downloaded the form from the college website should pay Rs.100.00.
2. Selection will be made on the basis of merit and the list of the selected candidates will be notified on the college notice board and in the college website in time. A candidate must admit himself / herself within a week of the announcement of the selection results. His / her claim after this date may not be entertained.
3. Total No. of Seats: As per NCTE guide line (latest).

Academic year: From July to June.

Courses offered:

- a) The college offer one year B.Ed. course prescribed by the Assam University, Silchar and NCTE. Classes of both and practice are taken.
- b) Practice teaching will be held for 20 + 20 = 40 classes (classes in both the methods).

Accommodation:

At presents it is non residential college and as such no facility for hostel accommodation or otherwise will be given.

Library:

The college has a library of its own with necessary reference books, periodicals and news papers, educational journals. Students can use the library during their leisure periods.

Laboratory:

- a) The college has science laboratory with necessary materials.
- b) The institute has a psychological laboratory.

Medium of instruction:

Medium of instruction is English.

Course structure

1. a) Compulsory subjects 400 marks

- i) Education in Emerging Society.
 - ii) Educational psychology of teaching and learning.
 - iii) Teacher and pedagogies of education.
 - iv) Recent trends and problem of education.
- (80 marks for theory and 20 marks for practicum in each paper)

b) Elective Course 100 marks

- i) Population education 50 marks
- ii) Guidance and Counseling 50 marks
- iii) Environmental education 50 marks

(The combination should be any two of the above three subjects)

(40 marks for theory and 10 marks for practicum in each paper)

c) Method subject: 200 marks

2. Contents cum methods: (Two subjects to be offered)

- i) Bengali
- ii) Social studies
- iii) English
- iv) Mathematics
- v) Physical Science
- vi) History
- vii) Life Science
- viii) Hindi

(80 marks for theory and 20 marks for practicum in each paper)

- 3. a) Practice teaching, internal test and a series of cultural and other co-curricular activities, seminar, group discussion etc. **200 marks**
- b) Final teaching and viva voce **100 marks**

Evaluation (Examination):

- a) Evaluation of internal assessment and sessional work including unit test is made by the teacher educators including principal.
- b) External assessment of the final teaching is done by the examiners appointed by the university as per program to be notified in due course time (April – May)
- c) External written final examination is generally held in the month of June every year.

Eligibility for appearing at the final examination.

- a) Minimum attendance in theoretical classes and co-curricular activities must be 80% of the total working days.
- b) Practice teaching and sessional works must be satisfactory.
- c) Dues must also be cleared.
- d) Library books etc. must be returned.
